### Sibling & Self-Advocate Programs

We also offer a track of workshops for Self-Advocates (people who have Down syndrome) to learn to maximize their potential and live healthy lives.

A schedule filled with the best people, and lunch by the best caterers would be nothing without the right facility to make it all work! MDSN's conference requires a space with 6-8 classrooms for workshops (with projectors and screens), an auditorium for keynote and space for 250 to sit down and eat lunch. Additional needs include free parking, the ability to set up the evening before the conference and the ability to stay past the end time (usually 5pm) to clean up and pack up. MDSN does have general liability insurance, and also secures event insurance for the conference.
